**Qualification:** In order to qualify for the World Finals Barrel Race, ABRA Members need to win at least \$1 as an ABRA Member between April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2008, and April 15, 2009. Non-qualifiers can still join and compete in the World Finals by simply buying-in (see the WFBR Entry Form for more details). The ABRA Rise Above Pro Tour is open to all female ABRA Members and will be run as one Long Go on Friday in the John Justin Arena (Carryovers will be allowed from the Open 5D), and the Top 10 will advance to the Short Go to be run in the Will Rogers Coliseum on Saturday night. Rise Above Pro Tour contestants can send in their memberships with their entries if not already a Member. Both WFBR and Rise Above Pro Tour contestants can enter as many different horses as desired and run in as many classes as their age allows. Rise Above Pro Tour contestants, however, may only advance their highest placing horse to the Short Go.

**How to Enter:** Completely fill out and send in an official WFBR Entry Form with a check or money order payable to ABRA, postmarked by April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009. **Pre-Entry Draw:** The WFBR Pre-Entry Draw & Rise Above Pro Tour Draw will be posted on [www.AmericanBarrelRacing.org](http://www.AmericanBarrelRacing.org) by May 1st. The Pre-Entry Draw will run before any late entries in both rounds of every class. The draws will be reversed for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Go.

**Late Entries:** All entries not received postmarked April 15<sup>th</sup> or earlier are considered late entries and will be charged as such.

**ABRA may refuse checks sent in after the April 15<sup>th</sup> postmark deadline, especially at the WFBR.** Late entries paid in cash will be taken at the WFBR until the first horse runs in the first go in each class. There will be a late fee of \$20 per entry charged for all entries not postmarked by April 15th, with a maximum penalty of \$50 per person including WFBR & Pro Tour entries combined.

**Carry Overs:** All contestants wishing to carryover times will run in the class that runs first and their time will be carried over to the second class, with the exception of Short Gos. Carryovers will not be allowed for Short Go runs. Decisions to carryover times must be made in writing on the ABRA entry form or in the ABRA Show Office prior to 9:30am on Friday, May 8<sup>th</sup>, at the latest, and cannot be changed.
