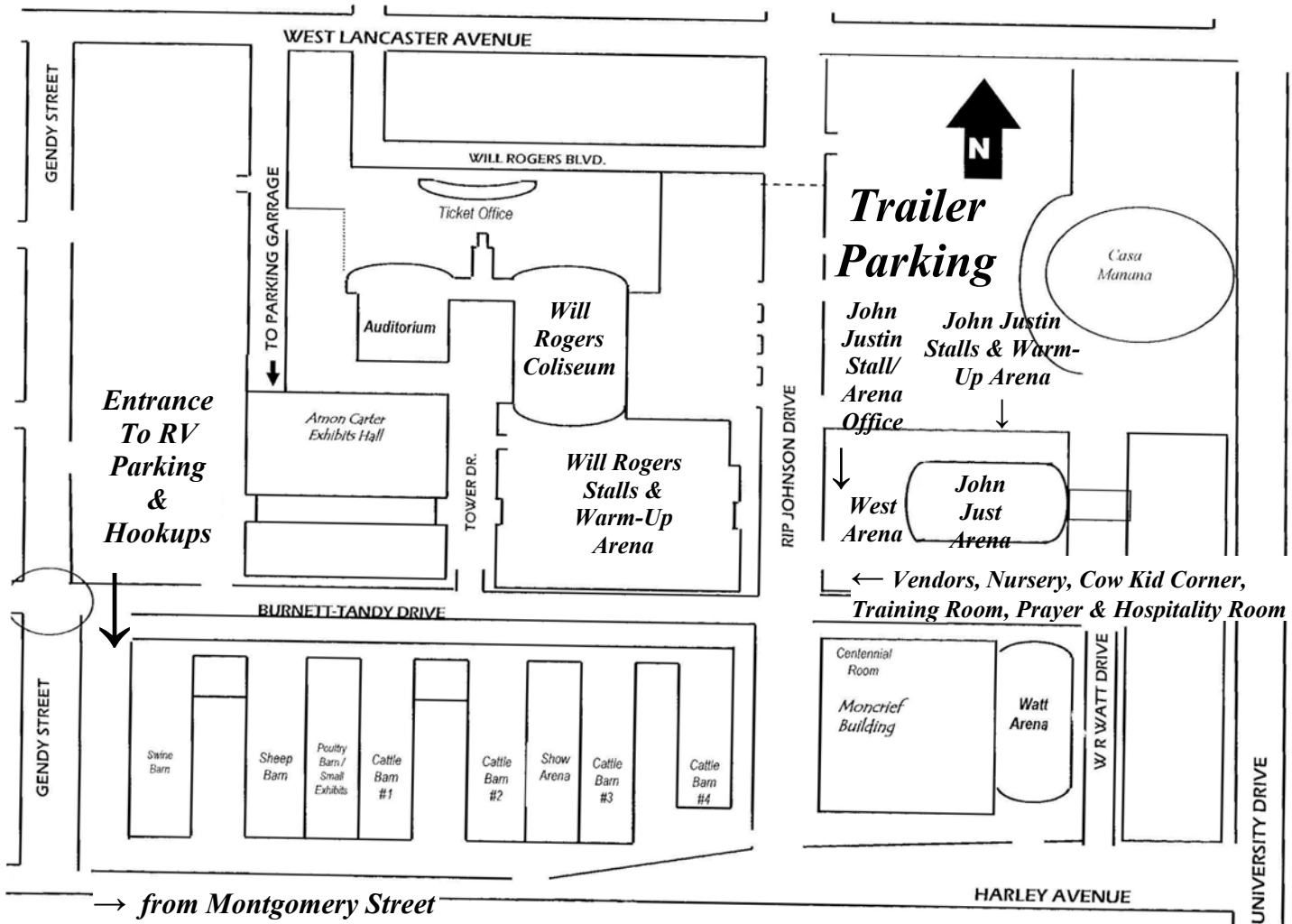


Will Rogers Memorial Center *Map & Facility Information*



Will Rogers Memorial Center, Fort Worth, Texas

The Will Rogers Memorial Center is the nicest facility the ABRA has ever rented. Both the John Justin Arena and the Will Rogers Coliseum have plenty of stalls and warm-up space located inside the buildings and there's even a tunnel to easily go back and forth between the two on horseback without having to cross the street! We'll have plenty of parking and a wonderful staff making sure that we all enjoy the weekend.

Directions to the Will Rogers Memorial Center

From Oklahoma City - Take Interstate 35 South to Denton and make sure to take the exit for 35 West to Fort Worth. In Fort Worth, take the exit for Interstate 30 West towards Abilene and look for the University Drive/ Montgomery Street exit. Take University Drive and head North. Turn Left on Harley Avenue, then Right on Rip Johnson Drive. Look for signs for the Stall Office on your Right at the John Justin Arena.

From Dallas or Abilene - Take University Drive off of Interstate 30 and follow the same directions as above.

From Waco - Take the 35 West split in Hillsboro to head towards Fort Worth. In Fort Worth, take the Interstate 30

West exit towards Abilene and look for the University Drive/ Montgomery Street exit. Take University Drive and head North. Follow the above directions.

RV, Electrical Hook-ups

All RV and electrical hook-ups are reserved on a first-come, first-serve basis at the entrance to the RV Parking & Hookup Area.

Stalls/ Shavings

All stalls will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis in the John Justin Arena building. Contestants will need to check in with the stall office to get their stall assignments before putting any horses in stalls. Shavings will need to be purchased from the Will Rogers staff office which will be located next to the ABRA Stall Office. 3 1/2 cubic feet bags are currently \$6.50; 10 cubic feet bags are currently \$12.
